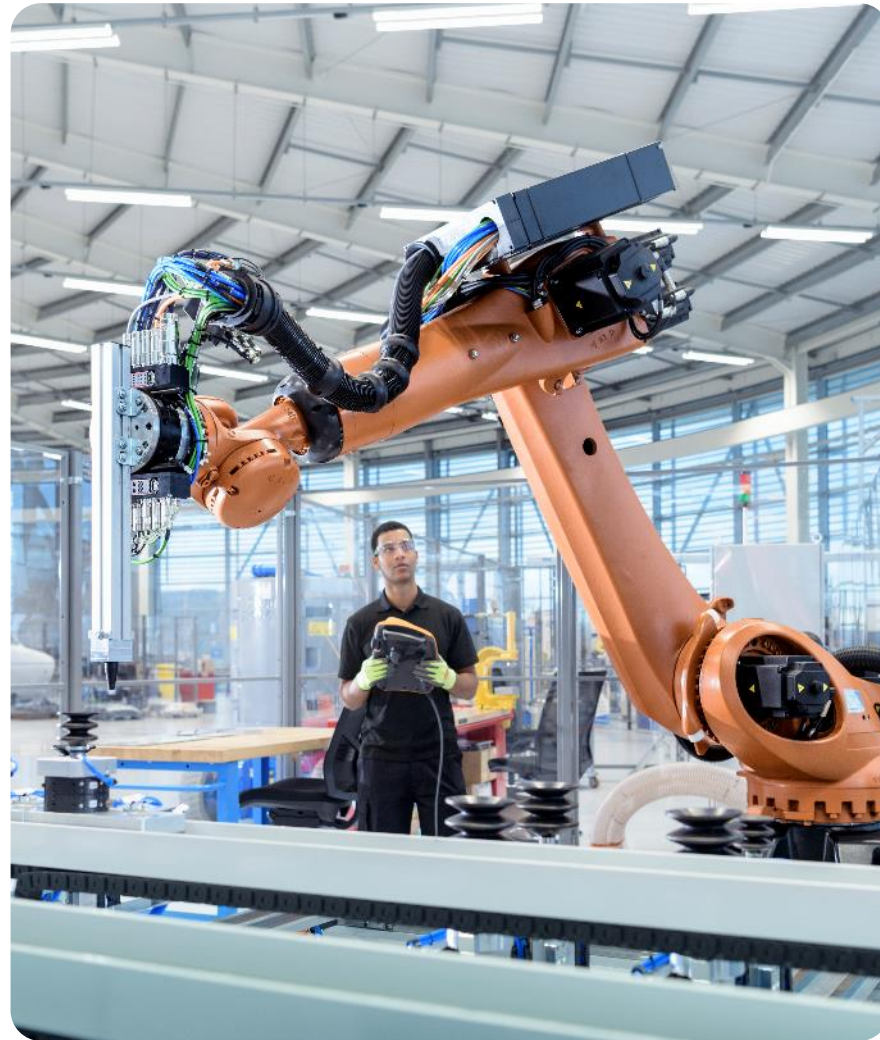

Local Labour Markets
