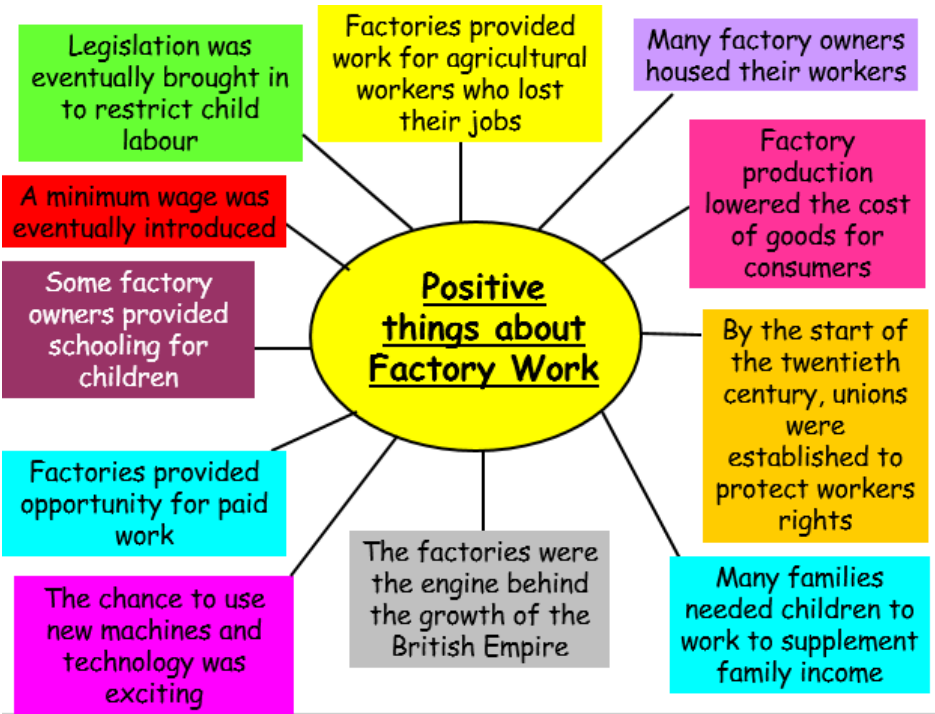


How did the Industrial Revolution Change Britain?

Positive things about Factory Work



Key Terms:

Industrial Revolution: In the years 1750-1900 a revolution took place in the way goods were produced. Mass production in factories replaced cottage industries.

Urbanisation: Process that ran alongside the Industrial Revolution. Many people moved from the countryside to the cities to work in factories.

Slums- Low quality housing in which people started to live in the 19th Century. Disease spread quickly in dirty, crowded conditions.

Child Labour - There were no laws about how old someone had to be to work in a factory. Many children worked long hours in terrible conditions.

The Railways - Steam power led to huge technological advances in transport. Goods and people could now be moved much faster than was possible before.
