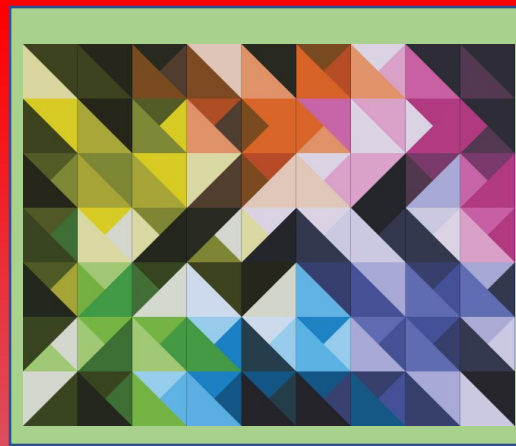

Art Skills For Drawing

- Perspective** - creates the sense of distance
- Composition** - the way in which different elements of an artwork are combined or arranged.
- Proportion** - relationships between height, width and depth
- Lighting** - gives a painting structure; showing our eyes that there are objects and shapes to be seen

Drawing Workshop Content

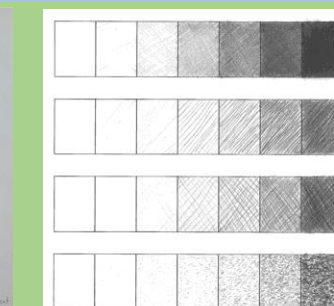
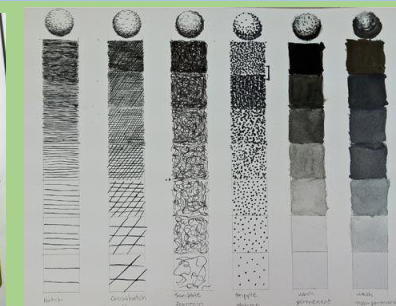
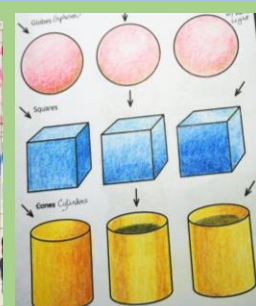
- Create drawings in various media and styles.

Key Terms

- Light** - emphasises features through highlights and shadow and creates depth
- Shadow** - heightens the illusion of depth in a painting
- Line** - used to define shapes and figures, but also to indicate motion and emotion.
- Pattern** - a design in which lines, shapes, forms or colours are repeated
- Tone** - to produce contrast within an artwork
