Focus Design Movement – Art Deco

- The name Art Deco is derived from the French phrase “Art Decoratif”.
- The visual style was first exhibited in Paris in 1925
- Aside from architecture and buildings, Art Deco style has also incorporated in other areas, including furniture, jewellery, clothing, and automobiles.
- Art Deco style uses striking geometric shapes and rectangular forms

Types of Wood

Soft wood – Pine and Spruce

Hard Wood – Oak and Mahogany

Man-Made (Manufactured) – Plywood and MDF / Chipboard

Focus Artist/Designer – Wassily Kandinsky

- Wassily Kandinsky 16 December 1866 – 13 December 1944 was a Russian painter, printmaker and art theorist.
- He was one of the most important 20th-century artists.
- He was a major figure in modern art and painted some of the first modern abstract works.
- His art changed several times during his life. It was fauvist, abstract, expressionist and constructivist in turn.

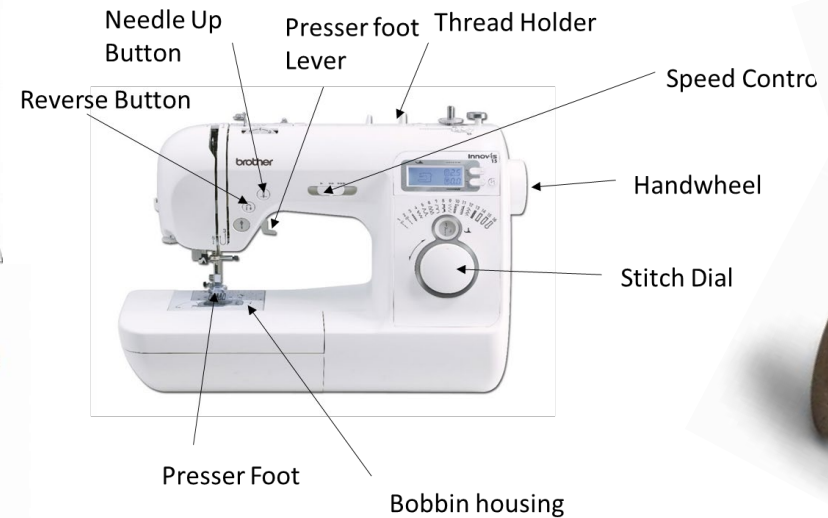
Top Tips for Successful Designs – From our year 10 students

- Allow the research to find the next artist for you/

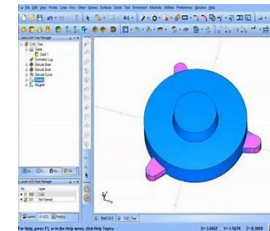


Focus Artist/Designer – Romero Britto
