*The simple future tense*

*End in an 'en' and you find them in a dictionary*

**What affect do dative prepositions have on der, die, das and die?**

*Change them to dem, der, dem and den*

**What do T, M and P stand for and what do they mean?**

*Time, Manner and Place; the order the information comes in in a German sentence*

**Can you label this perfect tense sentence: Ich habe Fußball gespielt**

*habe = auxiliary verb*

*gespielt = past participle*

**When does the auxiliary verb need to be a form of 'sein'?**

*When there is movement into or towards something or somewhere*

**What affect do subordinating conjunctions have on word order?**

*Send the verb to the end: weil ich The Simpsons liebe*

**What affect do modal verbs have on word order?**

*Send the verb to the end in its infinitive form:*

*Ich muss Hausaufgaben machen*

**Can you explain how you would form the long future tense?**

*Put conjugation of 'werden' second, then send verb to end in its infinitive form:*

*Ich werde ins Kino gehen*

**What does 'sein' mean?**

*To be*
