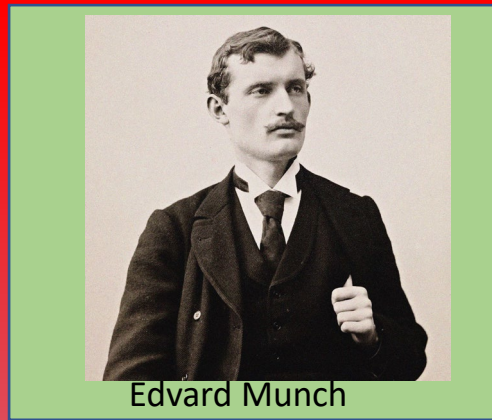


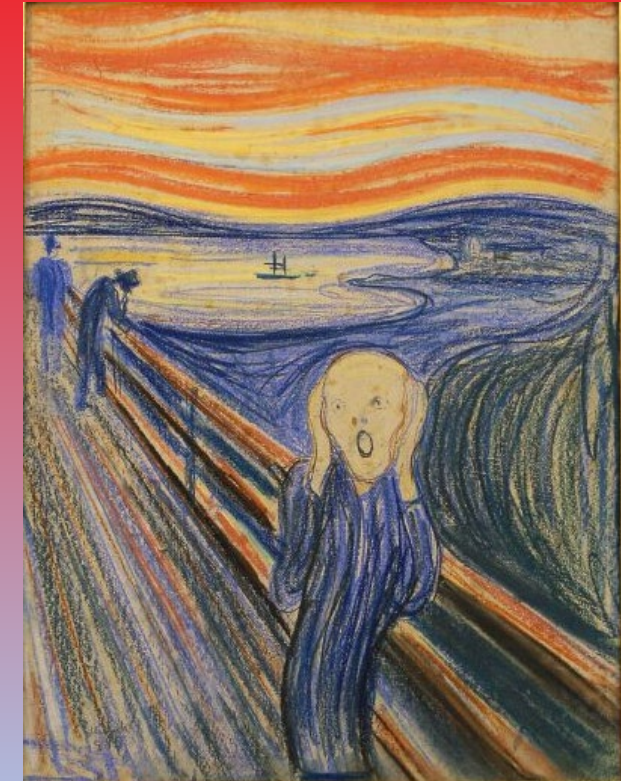
# Year 7 Artist Study

## Artist Study Workshop Content

**Practice** – Discussing artworks and how they influence others.

**Evaluate** – Why was your painting successful and how can you apply these skills to new work.

**Interpreting** – How was the work made? Look at colour/composition and technique.

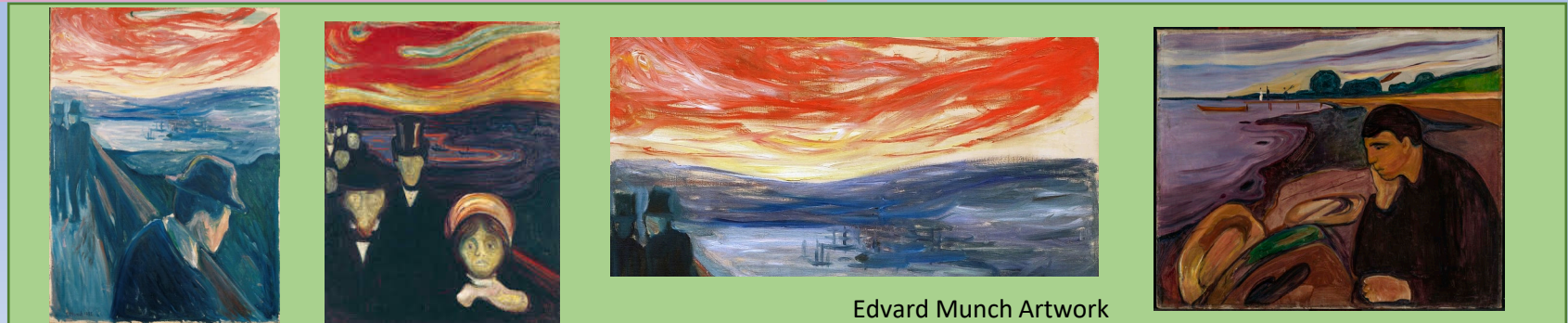
