Re: Uniform Expectations

At Chantry Academy we expect our students to take pride in their appearance and take their responsibilities as students seriously.

In recent weeks reminders have been given to all students around our uniform expectations and support has been given to students or families where necessary, in meeting those expectations.

Please can you inform your child that as of Monday 20 March, students who are inside the Academy building wearing a hooded jumper instead of their blazer, students who are wearing leggings, jeans, jeggings or tracksuit bottoms instead of black trousers and students who are wearing inappropriate shoes- without prior communication between parent and tutor- will be placed in an after-school detention.

The tutor will continue to check this each week until the uniform issue is rectified.
